NO broken glass or Pyrex



All broken glass must go in your waste bin - including broken bottles & jars, drinking glasses & window glass.
Pyrex crockery and pot lids must go in the waste bin.

NO plastic bags All plastic bags go in your waste bin or can be recycled at your nearest major supermarket.



NO soft plastic  
If you can scrunch it up, it goes in the waste bin. No plastic food wrap, shopping bags, frozen food /bread bags - even if they say they are recyclable!

NO polystyrene  
includes all types of polystyrene: foam, packaging, postage foam, coffee cups, bean bag beans/beads, take-away packaging etc.
